Just to back up for a moment, I discovered poetry when I was in high school. Sure, I had read children's poetry long before then, but I never really paid attention to what poetry really was or how it was written until my English teacher, Mrs. Jencks, got the class excited about Shakespeare and Chaucer...and pretty soon I was hooked! I loved the imagery and the flow of words and rhythm of formal, metered verse. Ironically, a free-verse poem I wrote during this time was selected for inclusion in a local college's literary magazine – and as a young kid seeing my name and poem in print, that was all it took to get me rolling!

Over the years, I have had several adult poems published in various independent collections (see “credits” for the complete list) and in 2009 I decided to make a concerted effort to break into the world of children's literature. When I left the security of a full-time paycheck in 2012 and quit my regular job to work from home and become a stay-at-home father to my 2-year-old son, I wasn't sure if it was the right decision. As one can imagine, it was a rather stressful undertaking – but I built up my voiceover business while devoting more time to developing my writing (in-between diaper changes and naps!) and before long, I was settling into my new routine.
